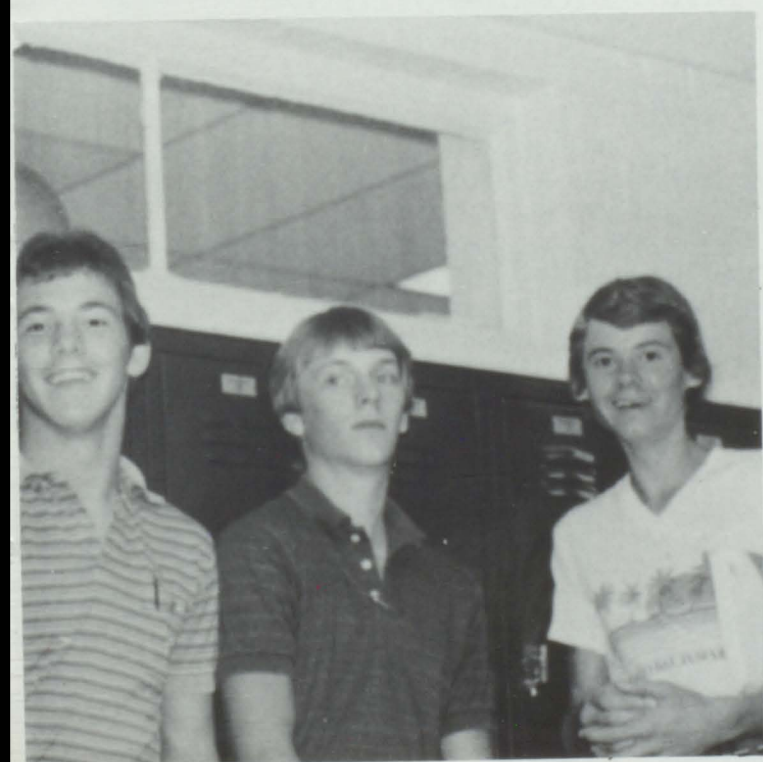




## COMIN' ALIVE IN '85

People of the community were invited to view the completed new construction and renovation of the school. Members of the Student Council registered approximately 250 guests while members of the FHA served refreshments.





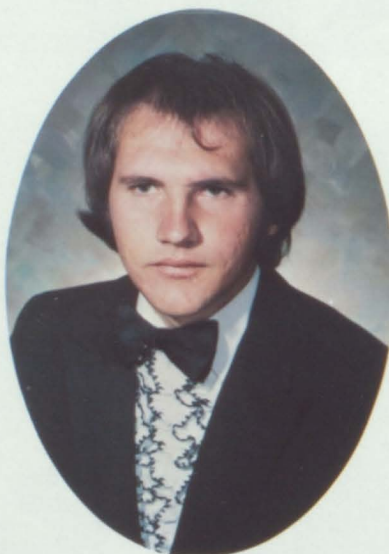
