MESSAGE TO THE SENIORS OF 1951

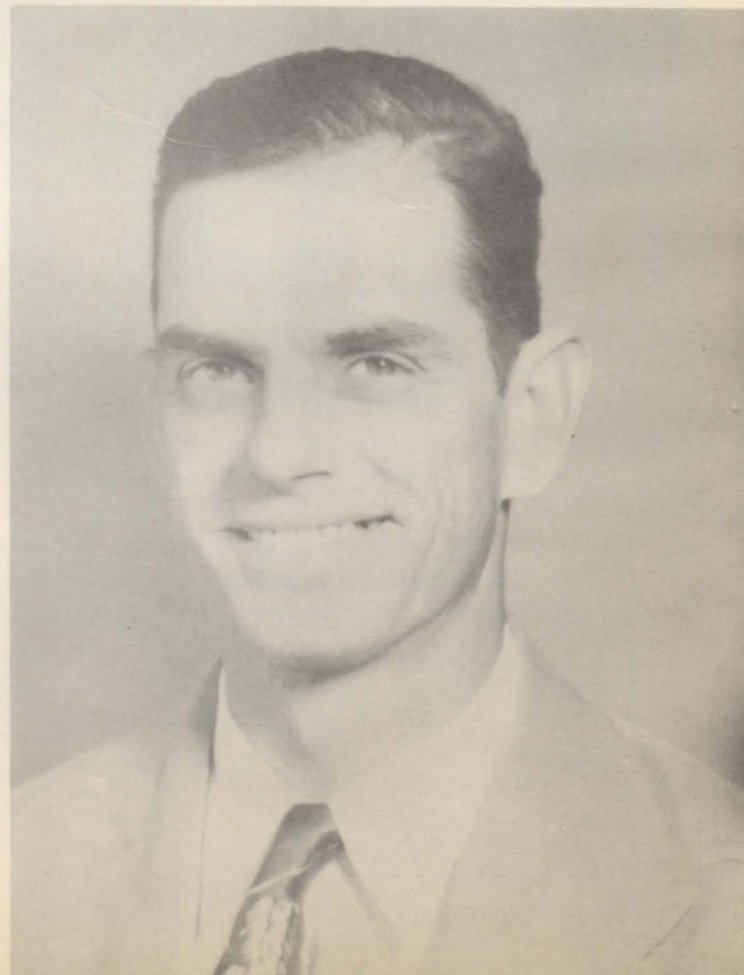
