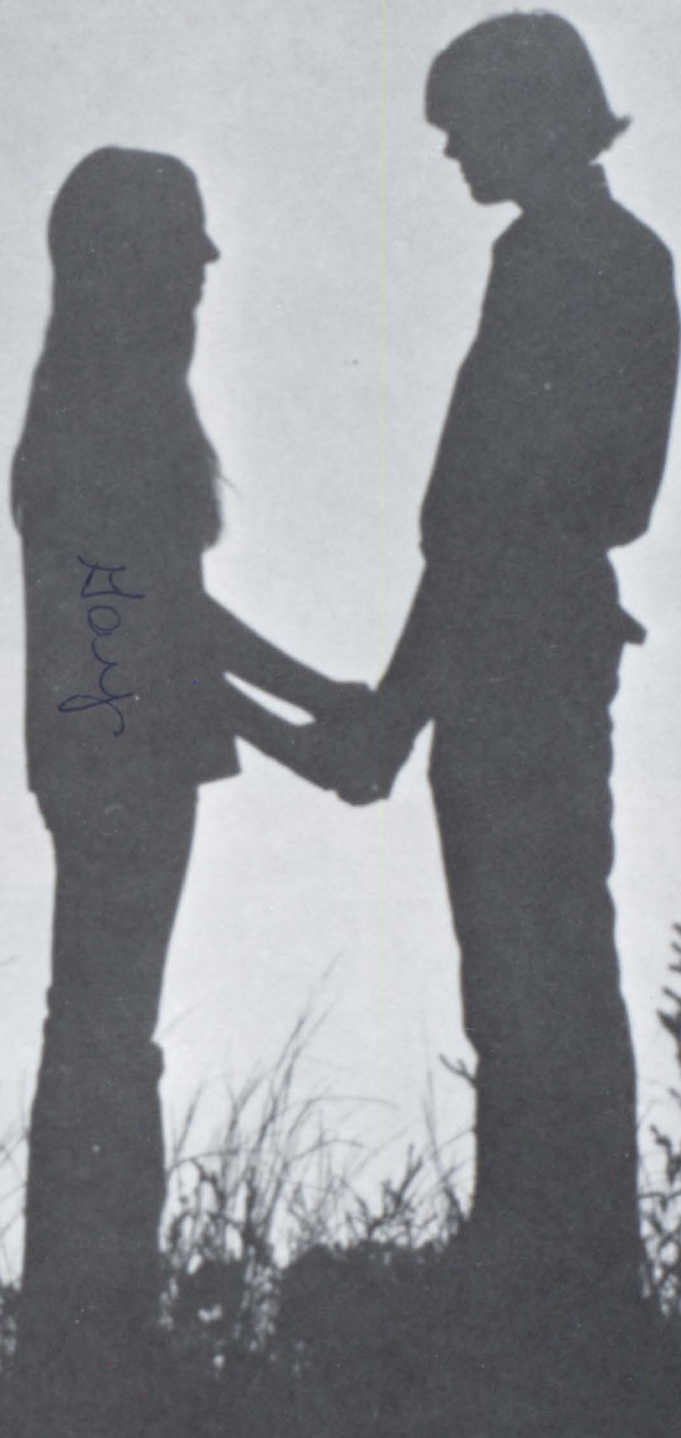
Your presence during our school years may have gone unnoticed many times, but you were always there when we needed you most.

There were many afternoons, long after we had gone home, that you remained to work in the silent halls and to close the doors behind us.

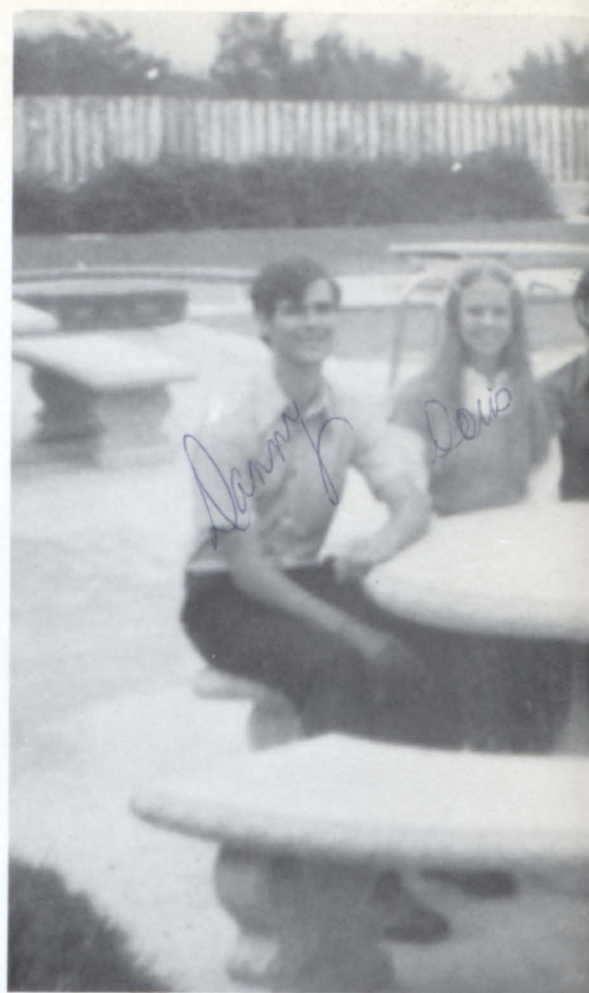
We remember seeing you raise the flag every morning, start the heaters in cold weather, and prepare the gym for ballgames. But most of all, we remember your kind and gentle ways.
