

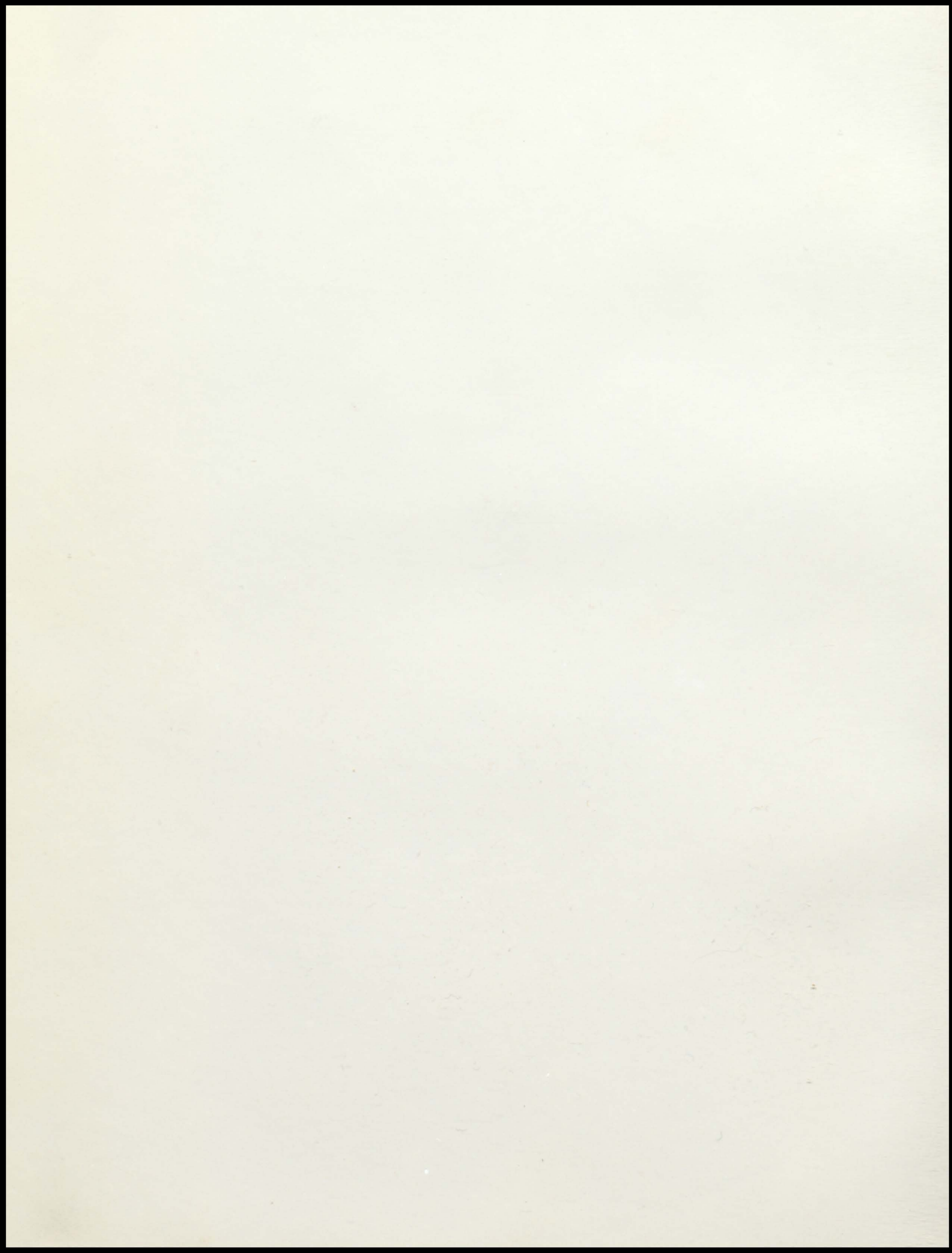

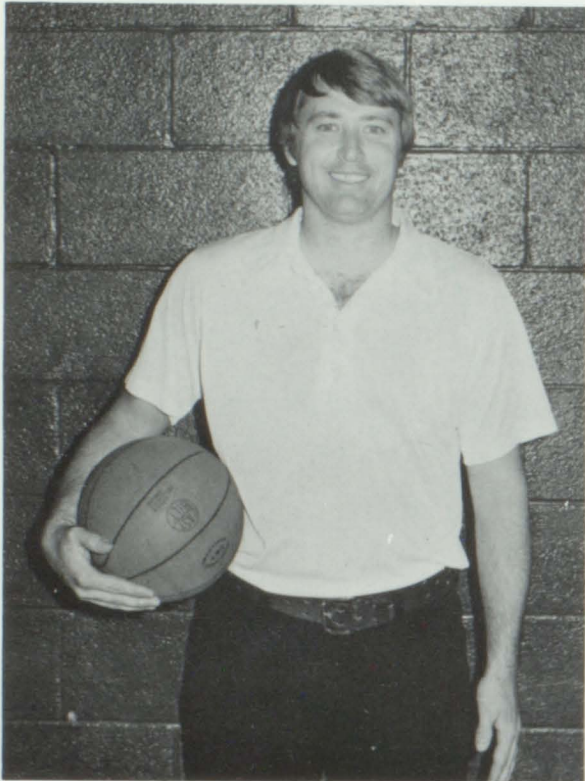

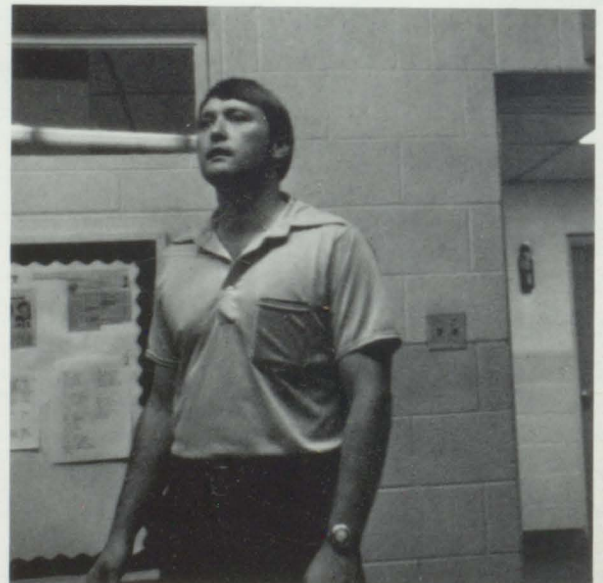


Dreams throughout our High School years may have seemed like only faraway visions, but because of Stan Pulliam, many of those dreams became realities.

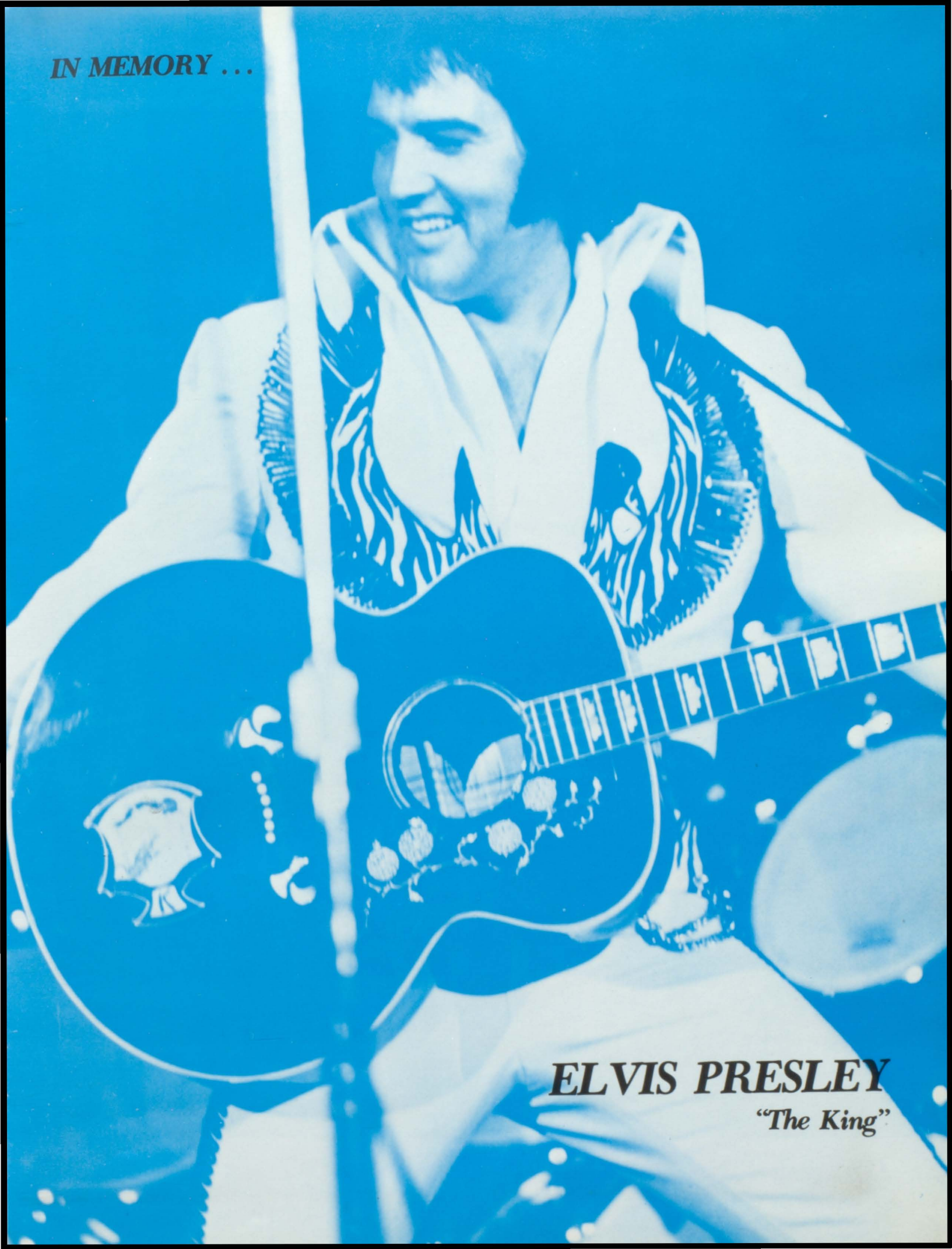
All of Sands High School has shared in the victories of Coach Pulliam and his teams. He helped the school and community create a spirit that will forever hold a place in our hearts.
