Policy for Handling Complaints of Discrimination

Policy:

Sands CISD cafeteria will display the updated nondiscrimination poster in a prominent location for public viewing in the service area.

Procedures:

Any person alleging discrimination based on race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability has a right to file a complaint. All complaints may be made in writing, verbally, or in person. The complaint form can be found in school cafeteria, and on the school website.

SFA procedure will be as follows:

- If assistance is requested, the District Staff will:
 1. Listen to any complaint or concern and provide the complainant with the discrimination complaint form that either the complainant will complete or SFA staff will complete.
 2. The completed form will be forwarded to the CE Superintendent.
- The CE Superintendent will forward the discrimination complaint form to the Food and Nutrition Division of the Texas Department of Agriculture at:

- Complaint maybe filed directly to TDA at the address above or directly to USDA by following the directions below.

In accordance with Federal civil rights law and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) civil rights regulations and policies, the USDA, its Agencies, offices, and employees, and institutions participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, sex, disability, age, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA.

Persons with disabilities who require alternative means of communication for program information (e.g. Braille, large print, audiotape, American Sign Language, etc.), should contact the Agency (State or local) where they applied for benefits.
