

ESC17 has created this worksheet to assist districts with the many requirements of Truth in Taxation. The information and instructions are based on our understanding of guidance from the State Comptrollers Office Truth in Taxation website. Districts are advised to seek legal counsel if they have questions regarding the laws and requirements regarding the tax rate adoption process, related actions, and posting requirements. Updated for State Comptroller Truth in Taxation as of May 11, 2026.

This worksheet is used to assist with the Truth in Taxation (TNT) requirements related to the board adopting a tax rate and the additional requirements for language and website postings. The district will need to also complete the worksheet "Data Entry_Adopted Budget" or use their own version to post to the website. Be sure the posted budget includes the tax worksheets (Form 50-859 or 50-884) as an appendix.

Once the "Data Entry" worksheet is completed, the district should make pdf documents of the "Website Postings" and the "Data to Send AssessorCollector" worksheets so they may be posted to the websites more easily. The board approvals may just be printed to refer to for required board actions.

Complete the highlighted cells in the table below. Then, review the "Board Approval" worksheet for TNT requirements as part of the board actions when adopting the tax rate. Also review the "Website Postings" worksheet for items, which will require posting based on the information contained below. You may wish to refer to the Truth in Taxation guidance on the Comptrollers website for review of required postings.

Post notice under the Texas Open Meetings Act (OMA): In addition to the notice described above, a district must post notice of the meeting in accordance with the OMA. If a board plans to adopt the budget and tax rate at the same meeting, the meeting notice must list separate agenda items for the budget and tax rate, in that order. The board may also conduct any other business properly posted under the OMA at the meeting.

NEW REQUIREMENT EFFECTIVE 9-1-2025

The Open Meetings Act notice of a school board meeting at which the budget will be discussed or adopted must include:

- a physical copy of the proposed budget (or ensure the proposed budget is clearly accessible on the district's website)
- include a **taxpayer impact statement** that compares the property tax bill for the current fiscal year to the upcoming fiscal year

Board Approval

Usually a school district adopts its tax rate after it adopts its budget. The school board may adopt the budget and tax rate after the public meeting, but the budget must be adopted before the tax rate.

A school district with a fiscal year beginning July 1 that adopts a budget based on an estimated appraisal roll must wait to adopt the tax rate until after the certified appraisal roll or certified estimate of taxable value is received.

Not Required

A school district determined by TEA to have Excess Local Revenue must wait to adopt a tax rate until the commissioner of education certifies the district may proceed with the adoption of a tax rate.

Yes, Required

If the board wishes to adopt a tax rate that includes an I&S tax rate greater than the minimum I&S debt rate: Before the district adopts its tax rate, it must first approve the I&S tax rate that exceeds the minimum amount needed to service the district's debt in a separate motion and vote.

Yes, Required

Required motion to approve a debt rate higher than the minimum debt service rate.

#N/A

Yes, Required

This motion must pass with a 60% vote of board members (5 of 7 members).

If the vote does not pass with 5 of the 7 members voting for the higher debt rate, the board **MAY NOT** adopt the proposed I&S rate that exceeds the minimum debt rate. **Adopt the minimum debt service rate.** The TNT Tax Calculation Worksheet with the minimum debt services rate will be the FINAL form and attached as an appendix to the adopted budget.

If the vote passes with at least 5 of the 7 members voting in favor of the motion, then a new TNT Tax Calculation Worksheet must calculate the VATR. If you created two versions of the calculation worksheets, the version with the district's higher I&S rate will be the FINAL worksheet appended to the budget and used to send out for online databases as required by the Tax Code.

No taxing unit or school district may impose property taxes in any year until its governing body has adopted a tax rate for that year and set it out in an ordinance, resolution or order. Taxing units should consult legal counsel regarding the correct instrument and wording to use for tax rate adoption, but the Tax Code sets out specific wording to be included.

School Districts: If a proposed tax rate exceeds the sum of no-new-revenue maintenance and operation (M&O) tax rate and debt rate, at least 60 percent of the governing body must vote in favor of the ordinance, resolution or order by a record vote.

If the ordinance, resolution or order sets a tax rate that imposes an amount of taxes to fund M&O expenditures that exceeds the amount of taxes imposed for that purpose in the preceding year, it must include the following statements in type larger than the type used in any other portion of the document:

Adopting a tax rate before the budget (this method is usually only used when a VATRE is being considered)

If the school district elects to adopt a tax rate before receiving the certified appraisal roll, it may adopt its budget after it adopts a tax rate for the tax year in which the fiscal year covered by the budget begins.

If a school district elects to adopt a tax rate before adopting a budget, it must publish notice and hold a meeting for the purpose of discussing the proposed tax rate.

Following adoption of the tax rate, the school district must publish notice and hold another public meeting before it may adopt a budget.
