

# History of A-F Accountability Ratings


- 2017-2018– Only districts received A-F
- 2018-2019– Both districts and campuses received A-F
- 2019-2020– No Ratings (COVID)
- 2020-2021– No Ratings (COVID)
- 2021-2022– Districts and campuses received A,B,C or Not Rated
- 2022-2023– Blocked by litigation until April 2025
- 2023-2024– Still blocked by litigation as of April 2025
- 2024-2025– Expected in August 2025

# Domain I: Student Achievement

- For Elementary & Middle School, the Domain I score is based completely on STAAR scores for all grades & tested subjects on the campus. (Grades 3-8) (Math, Reading, Science, Social Studies)
- For high schools and K-12 campuses, the Domain I: Student Achievement score is based on three components:
  - STAAR performance is 40% of the Domain I score
  - College, Career, Military Readiness (CCMR) is 40% of the Domain I score
  - Graduation Rate is 20% of the Domain I score

# Domain II: School Progress

- Domain II, Part A: Academic Growth
  - Measures whether students showed academic growth in Math and Reading from the previous year's STAAR test to the current year's STAAR test. (For 2023 ratings, growth is measured from 2022 STAAR to 2023 STAAR)
- Domain II, Part B: Relative Performance
  - Elementary/Middle Schools-- Evaluates the overall student performance on STAAR compared to campuses/districts with similar percentages of economically disadvantaged students.
  - High Schools/ K-12s-- Evaluates the overall student performance on STAAR AND CCMR compared to campuses/districts with similar percentages of economically disadvantaged students.



# Sands CISD Domain II: School Progress Score

Domain II Part A: Academic growth score for 2023 is 69.

Domain II Part B: Relative Performance score for 2023 is 88.

# Over-all Progress

The best score from Domain I: Student Achievement and Domain II: School Progress (consisting of Academic Growth & Relative Performance) counts as 70% of the overall campus or district rating.



Domain I Student Achievement Score: 88

Domain II part A: Academic Growth Score: 69

Domain II part B: Relative Performance Score: 88

For Sands CISD, the highest of these scores is 88, which will contribute 70% to the overall campus score.

# Domain III: Closing the Gaps

- 30% of overall campus or district rating
- Measures whether the following student groups meet federal performance targets
  - All Students Group
  - 2 lowest performing Racial/Ethnic Groups from previous year
  - High-Focus Group (includes special ed, economically disadvantaged, migrant, homeless, foster)



# Domain III: Closing the Gaps (continued)



## Elementary/Middle Schools

- Measures whether students meet federally-established performance targets for:
  - Academic Achievement (students scoring at Meets Grade Level or above in Math and Reading)
  - Academic Growth (from Domain II part A)
  - English Learner Proficiency (based on TELPAS)
  - STAAR Performance

## High Schools/K-12s

- Measures whether students meet federally-established performance targets for:
  - Academic Achievement (students scoring at Meets Grade Level or above in Math and Reading)
  - College, Career, Military Readiness (CCMR)
  - Graduation Rate
  - English Learner Proficiency

# Sands CISD Domain III: Closing the Gaps Score

Domain III: Closing the Gaps score for 2023 is 92.

Planned Action Steps (or steps already taken since 2023):

# Overall Campus Score

Best score from Domain I: Student Achievement and Domain II: School Progress --  $88 \times 70\% = 61.6$  points

Domain III: Closing the Gaps score-  
 $92 \times 30\% = 27.6$  points

Overall campus score is **89.2**.



# Overall District Score

District ratings are calculated using a proportionality method. The grades 3-12 enrollment for each campus determines the proportional percentage each campus contributes to the total district score.

Sands CISD is only one campus.

Sands CISD's overall preliminary rating for the 2023 school year is **B**.
